MDAAP: COVID-19 Response



- COVID-19 and Its Effect on Private Practice Pediatricians meetings
- Advocating with State Leaders
- Survey Members regarding SARS-COV-2 Testing Capacity (N=107)
 - Only 45% of respondents reported sending out PCR Testing
 - Only 20% of respondents reported doing in-house POC Testing
 - Availability of testing materials, protocols, and space were greatest reasons for not testing
