

Distance Learning and Safety Resources for Surrounding Jurisdictions

Alexandria County Public Schools (ACPS)

- **Distance Learning Eligibility:**
 - Parental choice on semester basis: completely [in-person or virtual learning](#) for the fall 2021.
 - Families that did not complete their learning choice form by May 24 will be automatically enrolled in in-person learning.
 - **In-person learning** will feature five days per week in classrooms with ACPS teachers.
 - **Virtual option** through [Virtual Virginia](#). Families opt in on a semester basis. Virginia-certified teachers will teach core classes online with daily synchronous activities as well as asynchronous learning experiences. Virtual students will still have access to ACPS extracurricular activities and athletics.

- **Distance Learning Eligibility:**
 - Parental choice: www.apsva.us/school-year-2021-22/
 - Five days a week of in-person learning or
 - Fully remote K-12 learning program.
 - *Families that did not submit their choice by April 30 were automatically placed in an in-person instructional model.*

- **Distance Learning Eligibility:**
 - Default is full-time, in-person
 - MCPS Virtual Academy will be available; application opens June 1. "Students interested in the program will be required to apply for admission and must be approved to participate."
